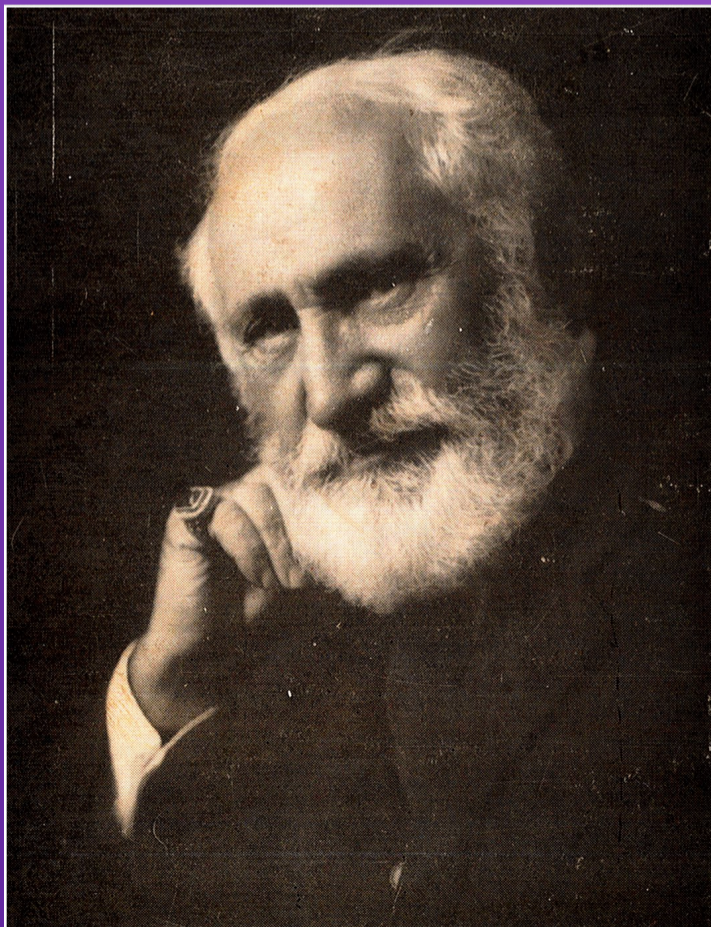

Catholicos, scholar, art historian, war hero, administrator, builder, Primate. **Catholicos Karekin I Hovsepian's** (1867-1952) was many things. But before and beyond all of that, he was a priest of the Armenian Church. His dedication to Christian faith as it is expressed in Armenian experience and tradition was absolute. It shaped his life, framed his responses to tumultuous events on three continents, and gave him the strength to persevere in the face of daunting obstacles.
