He also serves as a faculty ethicist for the Michigan Medicine Clinical Ethics program, and is a Professor of Music in the U-M School of Music, Theatre and Dance where he teaches physiology of the voice and vocal health. As a Laryngologist he specializes in laryngeal surgery, voice and airway disorders, including a



special interest in care of the professional voice. He is widely regarded as a leader in his field, and has published extensively in the related medical literature. He is also a longtime parishioner of the St. John Armenian Church of Greater Detroit.
