Charles has been in music ministry for 40 years as Organist, Minister of Music, Director of Music,



and Choirmaster in many cathedrals and churches. His extensive music career has included Minister of Music and Organist at National City Christian Church in Washington D.C.; associate organist at Detroit's Cathedral Church of St. Paul; and many churches in New York, Connecticut, and Michigan.

Charles has been featured in solo recitals at the National Cathedral and the Kennedy Center in Washington, D.C., St. Thomas Church and the Brick Presbyterian Church in New York City, York Minster, England and St. Paul's Cathedral, London. He performed three times for the Spoleto Festival in South Carolina and his 1995 performance there was featured on NPR's Pipedreams.

In addition to his position at Cherry Hill, Charles is President and Owner of Phillip Truckenbrod Concert Artists, LLC, a concert booking and artist management agency for concert organists.
