Yeprem Kelegian has served the Eastern Diocese for almost 50 years as a full-time pastor in Belleville Illinois, Hartford, Connecticut, and Racine, Wisconsin. Since his retirement in 2016, he has devoted himself to the Fund for Armenian Relief (FAR) as a Board Member and their Diocesan Parish Liaison. He is also active in social justice and environmental issues in his city, state, and nationally.
