Documentary Screening and Conversation with **SEDAT KIRAN, ARA DINKJIAN** **MURAT NIŞAN AND AYDA ERBAL**

NIŞO'S FLUTE tells the moving story of two artists, **NISHAN DIKRAN** (Master Nişo), an Armenian craftsman of wind instruments who returns to Diyarbakir after surviving the Armenian Genocide, and **ZÜLFÜ YOKUŞ** (Zilfo), a renowned Kurdish kaval player.

The screening will be followed by a presentation by musician and composer **ARA DINKJIAN** and a Q&A session with director **SEDAT KIRAN**, who will join via Zoom from Turkey and **MURAT NIŞAN** (Master Nişo's son). Artist and scholar **AYDA ERBAL** (New York University) will moderate the discussion. The film is in Turkish and Kurdish with English subtitles and a run time of 61 minutes.
